UNIcert® Test-Writing Toolbox:

Conceptualizing, Developing, and Constructing UNIcert® Exams for Languages for Specific Purposes

This AG concentrates on taking the UNIcert II, III, or IV exam from conceptualization to construction, concentrating mainly on Languages with Specific Purposes. We will tackle questions such as “What are the requirements of a UNIcert exam?” “How do I find a topic for the UNIcert exam?” “Which topics are suitable?” “Which exam tasks are relevant for each level?” “How can I find appropriate materials?” “How can I tell if the material is at the proper level?” The ultimate goal will be for each small group to produce a working UNIcert exam concept by the end of the workshop.

Although this AG will be conducted predominantly in English, there will be an opportunity to work with other languages during the small group session. However, the majority of the workshop, along with the materials provided, will be in English.

All participants are encouraged to bring a laptop, tablet, or smartphone in order to work on the planned activities.
